and a half millions since the year 1861! What an awful reflection for our present governors at Washington and the crowned heads of Europe, who have helped to murder such a vast number of ignorant human beings by a misplaced philanthropy!

I have now finished my criticism of the work of "Ariel," which embodies a great many arguments and a strong array of facts and proofs in support of the plurality of the human race.
